INTRODUCTION

The Riyadha Health & Welfare Services Group, under the umbrella of Riyadha Mosque and Islamic Centre Lamu, held its Annual Free Medical Camp, the 20th Edition since inception, from 17th October to 22nd October 2022. Like in all previous editions, it was held as part of the World famous Maulid Festival.
